The Bridge is a small but perfectly formed pub and restaurant in a village setting on the edge of Salisbury Plain. Inside is a beamed bar and log fire with displays of local paintings for sale. Outside, the large garden features a boule pitch. Light lunch options of baguettes and salads can be augmented by choosing a starter as a snack if you wish. Pub favourites are offered on the specials board – fresh haddock in beer batter; salmon, cod and dill fishcakes; and Wiltshire ham with free-range eggs and pomme frites. The distinctly French flavour of the main menu includes entrées of burgundy snails or warm smoked duck salad, and main courses of coq au vin or seared Badminton estate pheasant. Desserts include an irresistible sample of six miniatures from the carte. Regular fund-raising events include a 'rook supper' in May, harvest festival, and a charity beer festival over August bank holiday weekend.
